Questions from the forum

Cynthia McNerney: Updates on new data sources / planned acquisition to SAIL.

- Thanks to the MoJ team that attended today. This has been a major piece of work for most of the data acquisition team for the past 18 months, we appreciate all the works that has gone into that.
- In terms of the update mentioned, and the potential for linkage to census data as a future possibility.
 - Still in the early stages of ingesting this data into SAIL and making it available for researchers, so we would keep everyone updated through this forum and other sources once we've made progress with that.
 - We are also perceiving other data from/through ONS, there are a number of data sources that are on the horizon (Annual population survey, Covid infection survey etc.). We are working on these and would update you when available.
- Working with the Cystic fibrosis registry to try and get new and refreshed data.
- Still pursuing the UCAS data through ONS and local pharmacies.
- School health research network (SHRN) data, there is the student health and wellbeing survey that we have recently signed an agreement so the data will be available to us soon.
- In terms of existing data sources, we are continually working on refreshes/updates, including education data.

Questions from the forum

Hannah Davies: Updates from SAIL analytical team.

- Since the last forum and the update on GitLab sharing inside of SAIL, some issues have been found and are being worked on.,
- Continuing to update Metadata for all SAIL data sources, including the new MOJ data.

Julie Kennedy: Updates from SAIL Business team.

- The SAIL charging model has been updated, and the new version is due to go live by the end of this month.
 - There are no significant changes to charging at all, nothing is going up in price.
 - The main difference is that SAIL are introducing the concept of subscription users, it is a more cost-effective way of charging users who are on a large number of SAIL projects.
 - This will all be clear when the final version of the charging policy is released.
